## FY25 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Deadline Approaching

Applications are due Thursday, June 26, 2025

The Department of Transportation (USDOT) Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program application deadline is **Thursday**, **June 26**, **2025**, **at 5:00 PM ET**.

The estimated \$900 million in the FY2025 funding round will provide resources for regional, local and tribal initiatives focused on preventing roadway deaths and serious injuries. 911 centers may apply individually or in partnership with other eligible entities, including Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), Tribes, municipalities, counties or business improvement districts.

There is still time to apply for this funding by compiling:

- Key data for your jurisdiction & project areas
- A project narrative with problem identification
- A map & spatial file
- An estimated budget
