Mosquito Avoidance

Recent weeks have seen the return of West Nile Virus in Georgia. Mosquitoes are perhaps more plentiful this year thanks to above average rainfall, and of course they can transmit more than West Nile. 
RSS Validation

HURREVAC

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration hosted two-hour sessions Monday through Thursday this week to raise awareness of updates to the weather reporting tool HURREVAC as peak hurricane season approaches. The goal is to increase the lead times for advisories, watches and warnings. New color-coded customizable maps will provide forecast information for storm surge, rip currents, rainfall, and windspeeds. Presenters pointed out that each of the strongest hurricanes with greater than 150 mile per hour wind speeds to hit the U.S. in the past hundred years, had also been of tropical storm strength three days before landfall.

Tuesday next week will be the Region C Healthcare Coalition meeting to be held virtually. The Mid-Planning Meeting for the Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction / BioWatch full-scale exercise will be held Thursday at the state DPH office.
